Mental Health Services:

According to 2019 data from County Health Rankings and Roadmaps, Iowa County has an alarming shortage of mental health providers. CCFC is fortunate enough to have a volunteer Licensed Clinical Social Worker to see our clients in the same building as the clinic.

Free Clinic on Wheels:


Volunteers and our nurse manager traveled to six southwest Wisconsin farms to provide basic health screenings and checkups. In 2018 we acquired a mini bus from the Head Start Program and remodeled the interior to function as an exam room. We look forward to continuing to expand this program in 2020 to address rural health inequities and lack of access to transportation.

Diabetes Management Program:

In November, a volunteer Optometrist saw 17 of our clients for diabetic eye exams. We decided to follow up with these clients, as a majority have uncontrolled diabetes. A volunteer nurse, two registered dietitians, and a few interpreters are starting a program beginning in 2020 to help the clients learn to manage their disease and improve their overall health.




Volunteer nurses charting a patient's vitals on a farm visit.


Financial Report:
