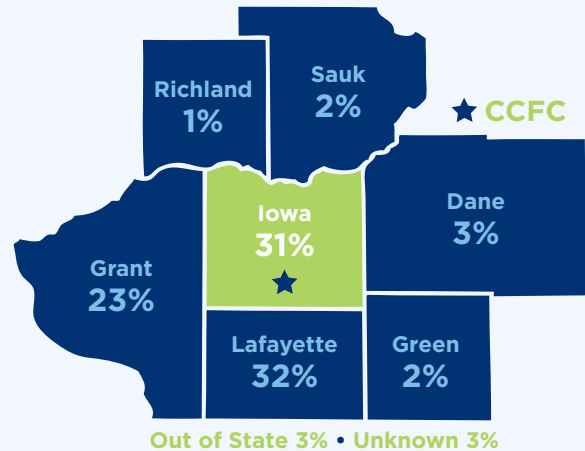

Services Provided

- ⊕ Held clinics every Tuesday afternoon and every Tuesday and Thursday evening.
- ⊕ Connected patients to Prescription Assistance Programs.
- ⊕ Hosted monthly clinics for procedures such as skin lesion removal.
- ⊕ Provided on-location health screenings at area farms and other locations with the Free Clinic On Wheels (FCOW).
- ⊕ Hosted Papapalooza, an event focused on the health needs of women.
- ⊕ Offered a Blood Pressure Program to patients diagnosed with hypertension. This program provides treatment, education, and coaching on how to manage blood pressure and provides each participant with a self monitoring blood pressure machine.
- ⊕ Connected patients to mental health providers through Oregon Mental Health Services.

Mission Statement: To provide basic health care for those who cannot afford or access medical services in Iowa County and surrounding areas.



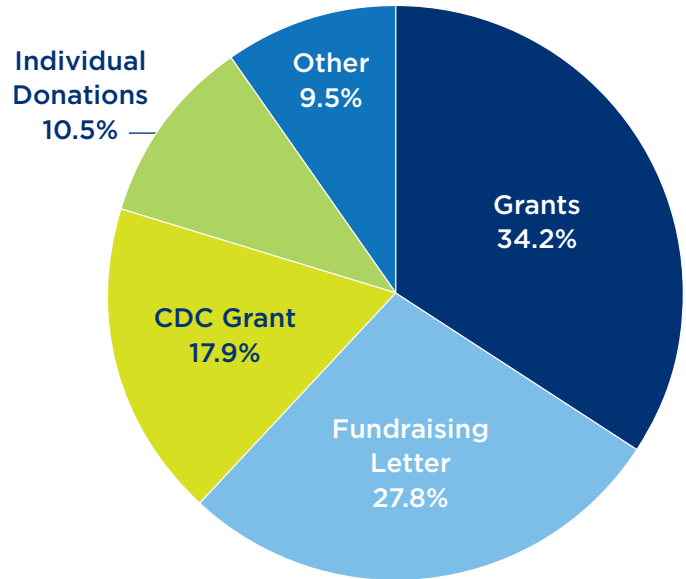

Financial Report

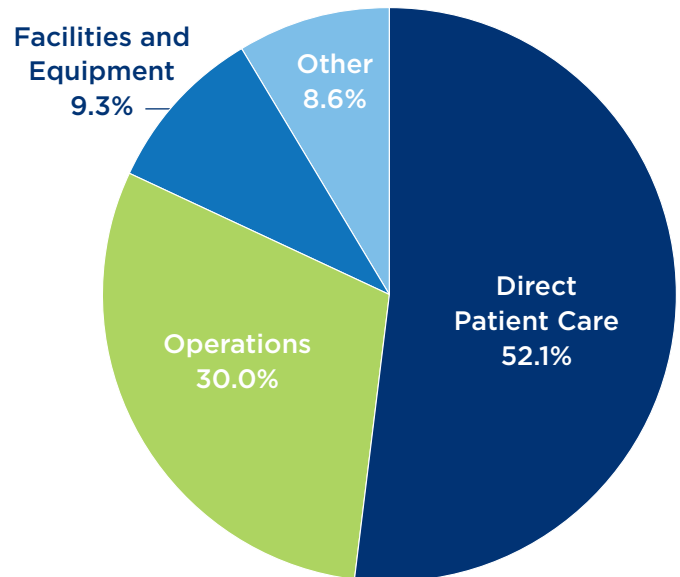
In 2021, several grants, restricted for purpose, were received from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Wisconsin Department of Health Services, United Fund of Iowa County, and the Wisconsin Association of Free and Charitable Clinics. Other grants, not restricted by purpose, were received from Morton Foundation, Compeer Financial, Racine Community Foundation, Mineral Point Community Chest, Wilkinson Auction & Realty Co., and anonymous donors. Total revenue in 2021 was \$279,519. The Other revenue category in the chart consists of Other 3.0%, Spring Auction 2.7%, Corporate Donations 1.9%, and Church Donations 1.9%

Over 50% of total 2021 expense was spent on Direct Patient Care. Total expense in 2021 was \$210,073. The Other expense category in the chart consists of Prescription Drug Assistance 5.9%, Supplies 2.0%, and FCOW Expense 0.7%.
